

## PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

### MODERNIZING INTERNATIONALIZATION TOOLS, PRACTICES AND STAFF COMPETENCES TO SUPPORT STUDENT-CENTERED LEARNING IN EASTERN PARTNERSHIP UNIVERSITIES

The present partnership Agreement, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement" is made and entered into force by and between

*KTH Royal Institute of Technology, hereinafter referred to as the "coordinator"*

and

*Khachatur Abovyan Armenian State Pedagogical University, hereinafter referred to as the "beneficiary".*

**The parties hereby agreed as follows:**

#### Article 1

##### Subject of the Partnership Agreement

1.1 This Agreement defines the terms that govern the relations between the parties, by establishing their rights and obligations, and lays down the rules of procedure for the work to be carried out in order to successfully implement the MODERNIZING INTERNATIONALIZATION TOOLS, PRACTICES AND STAFF COMPETENCES TO SUPPORT STUDENT-CENTERED LEARNING IN EASTERN PARTNERSHIP UNIVERSITIES INTERTOOL (hereinafter referred to as the "project").

1.2 The coordinator and the beneficiary, undertake to do everything in their power to carry out the work programme forming the subject of this Agreement.

1.4 The coordinator and the beneficiaries shall be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

1.5. The project eligibility period is January 1 2019 – December 31 2019.

#### Article 2

##### Obligations and responsibilities

2.1 Specific obligations and role of the coordinator.

The coordinator undertakes to:

- (a) be responsible for the overall coordination, management and implementation of the project;
- (b) inform the beneficiary of any changes connected to the project or of any event likely to substantially affect the implementation of the action;
- (c) manage and verify the appropriate spending of the funds;
- (d) provide the beneficiaries with any official documents related to the project

2.2 Specific obligations and role of beneficiary:

- (a) ensure adequate communication with the coordinator and with the other beneficiaries;
- (b) support the coordinator in fulfilling its tasks according to the project;
- (c) submit in due time to the coordinator all relevant data needed to draw up the reports, financial statements and any other documents;

- (d) provide the coordinator with any other information or documents it may require and which are necessary for the management of the project;

### Article 3

#### Working languages

- 3.1 The working language of the partnership shall be English.
- 3.2 Both parties commit in allocating to the project staff with enough knowledge of the working language, allowing a smooth communication and understanding of the matters discussed.

### Article 4

#### Termination of the Agreement

- 4.1 In the event that any of the beneficiaries fail to perform any obligations under the present Agreement, the coordinator may terminate their participation in the project.
- 4.2 The coordinator shall notify the beneficiary in cause by registered letter. The beneficiary has one month to supply all relevant information to appeal the decision.

### Article 19

#### Amendments

Any amendments to this Agreement must be made in writing by means of a Supplementary Agreement, and become effective when signed by the authorised legal representatives of both parties. No oral agreement may bind the parties to this effect.

### Article 20

We, the undersigned, declare to have read and accepted the terms and conditions of this Agreement as described here before.
